The Daybreak Rotary Club awards two high school seniors a four year \$5,000 scholarship that is payable \$625 per semester. The selected student is expected to maintain a 3.0 grade point average and to have continuous enrollment excluding summers. The recipients must send a copy of their college transcript each semester to continue to receive their award.

**Selection Process:**

The selection committee of Daybreak Rotary awards the scholarship on several criteria. Each criterion is equally weighted in the selection process. The criteria are academic, need, activities, personal and work. All information provided is held in the strictest of confidence and shared only with members of the Rotary Scholarship Committee.

**Application Process:**

The items needed for a complete application are: two letters of recommendation, your High School Transcript and a completed application form.

**Deadline:**

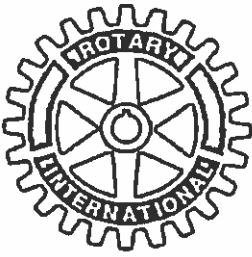
The deadline to turn in all documents is March 28, 2017.
